The Biathlon Bears program is a multi-tier developmental program for youth between 8 and 14 years of age. The program focuses on the delivery of cross-country ski and marksmanship fundamental skills in a fun and safe environment. The program runs from Mid-October to March 31 of the calendar year on Saturday afternoons between 1:30pm and 3:00pm at Kamview Nordic Centre.

For consideration of this position, the applicant must be:

- 18 years of age or older.
- Willing to work under direction of the LSB's Head Coach with minimal supervision.
- A great communicator with youth and adults alike.
- Competent and knowledgeable in freestyle cross-country (skating) techniques.
- Able to supervise and instruct a group of 10-15 youths for a period of time
- Able to work outdoors in fall and winter environments.
- Enthusiastic and passionate in the development of youth athletes.
- In possession of own skate skiing equipment.

In addition, the candidate is to submit the following.

- Lake Superior Biathlon Application Form as per Ref A.
- Coaching/Athlete Portfolio listing previous coaching and/or athlete experiences and positions held.
- Recent copy of a Police Record Check (PRC) and Vulnerable Sector Check (VSC) as required under Ref. A. The PRC and VSC must be valid as of 01 Mar 2021.

- Provide a letter of reference for the position sought as required under Ref A.
- NCCP transcript, if available, of NCCP courses and workshops undertaken. The transcript must demonstrate that the following modules have been completed.
 - Safe Sport Training Module.
 - Making Headway Concussion Module.

Renumeration for the position is based on the certification level of the applicant within the Biathlon Community Coaching Stream. Candidates holding certification levels of other sports will be taken into consideration during selection process.

All eligible candidates are encouraged to apply regardless of their level of coaching experience. In-house training and certification of coaches will be provided at no-cost to the successful applicants with exceptions to the firearms safety course and its licensing process.
